

# Well Woman Visit Coding Tips



## Breast Cancer Screening (BCS)

This measure evaluates women 50–74 years of age as of December 31 who had a mammogram to screen for breast cancer between October 31 two years prior to the measurement year and December 31 of the measurement year.

**Note:** The BCS measure assesses the use of imaging to detect early breast cancer in women.

- All types and methods of mammograms (screening, diagnostic, film, digital or digital breast tomosynthesis) meet this measure.
- MRIs, ultrasounds or biopsies do **not** count.

## Cervical Cancer Screening (CCS)

Measure evaluates women who were screened for cervical cancer using any of the following criteria:

- Women ages **21–64** who had cervical cytology performed within the last three years
- Women ages **30–64** who had cervical high-risk human papillomavirus (hrHPV) testing within the last five years
- Women ages **30–64** who had cervical cytology/high-risk human papillomavirus (hrHPV) cotesting within the last five years

**Documentation must include a note indicating the date the test was performed and the result or finding.**

**Excludes:** Women who had a prior hysterectomy with no residual cervix, cervical agenesis or acquired absence of cervix any time during the member’s history through December 31 of the measurement year. Documentation of hysterectomy alone does not meet the criteria because it is not sufficient evidence that the cervix was removed.

## Chlamydia Screening (CHL)

This measure evaluates women ages 16–24 who are sexually active\* and had at least one test for chlamydia during the measurement year. Chlamydia tests can be completed using any method, including a urine test.

**Documentation must include a note indicating the date the test was performed and the result or finding.**

\**Sexually active* is defined as a woman who has had a pregnancy test, testing or diagnosis of any sexually transmitted disease, is pregnant, or has been prescribed birth control.
