

Controlling Blood Pressure (CBP)

- ▶ **If blood pressure is elevated, retake it.** The taken combination of lowest readings during a visit is acceptable.
- ▶ **Only the most recent blood pressure that is < 140/90 is compliant.** Any reading \geq 140/90 is not compliant.
- ▶ Ensure that the blood pressure cuff is the correct size for the patient's arm and that it is providing accurate readings.
- ▶ Do not round numbers up when using an automatic blood pressure machine.
- ▶ Review the patient's medication list at every visit.
- ▶ Educate patients on the importance of medication compliance.
- ▶ During telehealth or telephone visits, allow readings taken by a member with any digital device. Also, during these visits, a blood pressure reading does NOT require a remote monitoring device to be the source.
- ▶ During telehealth or telephone visits, exclude readings taken by a member using a non-digital device, such as a manual blood pressure cuff and stethoscope.
- ▶ All blood pressure readings should be billed and included in claim submissions.
- ▶ Consider scheduling routine and follow-up appointments for members with hypertension.
